AfD files criminal complaint against German Chancellor Merz

Germany's right-wing AfD party has filed a criminal complaint against Chancellor Friedrich Merz after he accused them of promoting ethnic cleansing. The complaint follows the AfD's victory in Saxony-Anhalt regional elections where they received 43.8% of the vote. Merz's CDU party finished second with 17.2%.

His baseless and repugnant remarks directed not only at the party itself, but also at millions of German citizens, Merz has crossed a line in a way that carries criminal implications.
